
Reading at home during the school closure

At school, we use Accelerated Reader to monitor children's reading and their progress with reading. We feel this is making such a massive difference to all children's reading so it is great news that we are able to give you access to this resource at home during this time. It means your child is able to continue to read books which are at the appropriate level for them and the teachers will still be able to monitor their progress as they choose and take quizzes.

Children can still be reading texts which are within their ZPD, every child should have this. There are two ways which you can do this from home. The first is by going to <u>https://www.arbookfind.co.uk/</u>. On this website you can check any book which your child is reading or that you have at home to see what the Book Level is.



The second is by going to <u>https://readon.myon.co.uk/library/search.html</u> this website has a wide range of books which can be read on screen and also with an audio option for less confident readers.

You will need to search English language as these are books which definitely have quizzes on our Accelerated Reader site.



When you hover over a book you will be given the option for Info click on this to check the Book Level.
