

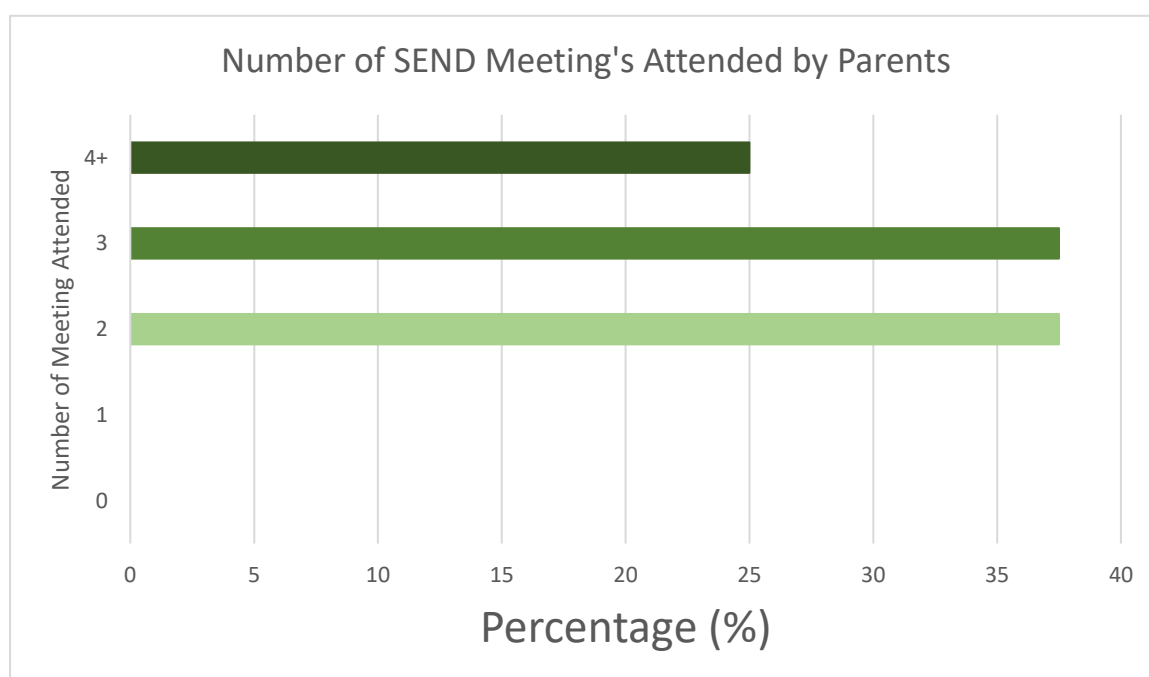
### **SEND Survey Summary**

Out of those who took the survey, 66% were known to the SEND Team and receiving SEND Support in some form. The spread over responses was the following:

Year 4	15.38%
Year 5	7.69%

All our parents knew who their designated member of the SEND team was.

Out of the 66% who were known to the SEN team, everyone reported having the correct number of SEN Meeting's (in line with our policy – at least 1 a term), with a significant number receiving even more than this!



Those that have attended these meetings told us:

Year Group	Percentage of respondents
How many of you received your child's targets?	100%
How many of you were made aware of what the school is doing for your child?	100%
How many of you were given strategies you could use at home to support?	87.5%

You also identified that the most likely person you would speak to about your concerns would be your class teacher. Some of you even left comments commenting on how helpful you have found the class teachers this year.

There was one area that the majority of you identified that we need to improve at, and that was sign posting where our SEND policy would be. We are working on a way to improve this over the following year.
