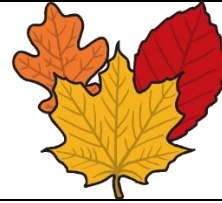

Key Vocabulary

Seasons	There are four seasons in the year, each one lasts for 3 months.
Autumn	Autumn is the season between summer and winter when the weather becomes colder and the leaves fall off the trees
Weather	The weather includes the temperature outside, such as cold, warm and hot. It also includes conditions such as wind, snow
Deciduous	Trees that lose their leaves in the cooler weather.
Hibernate	Animals that hibernate spend the winter in a state like a deep sleep.

What happens in Autumn?



Deciduous trees leaves change colour from green to gold, red and orange before they turn brown and fall to the ground.



Some animals such as the hedgehog hibernate for the cooler months. They collect and eat a lot of food, such as berries before rolling up in a ball and falling asleep in a mound of leaves.



The weather may be slightly sunny, windy or rainy. There are more clouds in the sky during autumn compared to summer



As the weather cools down you might begin to wear coats trousers, tight and hats on colder days - especially as it gets closer to winter.



In the autumn, there are events such as Remembrance day, Bonfire Night, Halloween and Diwali.
