| Roots | Roots suck up the water from the soil and help to keep the plant in the ground. |
| Stem | The stem hold the plant up and transports water to the leaves and flower. |
| Petals/Flowers | Petals are the colourful part of the plant, they attract bees and birds. |
| Leaves | Leaves catch the sunlight and help the plant to make its food. |
| Seeds | Seeds grow into new plants. |
| Bulbs | Bulbs grow into new plants. |
| Wild Plants | A wild plant grows where its seed falls. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for to help it grow. |
| Garden Plants | Garden plants are plants that people buy and choose to grow in their gardens. They are planted and watered to help them grow. |
| Evergreen | An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in Winter. |
| Deciduous | Deciduous trees lose their leaves in the Winter season. |
