

## Literacy

During the second half of the Spring term, in Literacy, we will be reading the books 'Goldilocks' 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and 'The Three Little Pigs'.

We shall be exploring the text, familiarising ourselves with the stories and developing our understanding of the key vocabulary.

We will be developing both communication and language skills, and literacy skills, to enable us to produce a piece of writing for each of the stories.

**The objectives that we are working towards are:**

- ~ To Write short sentences with words with known sound-letter correspondences using a capital letter and full stop.
- ~ To Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.

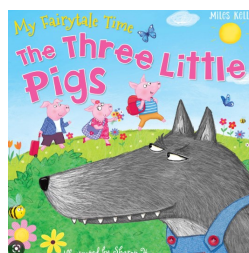
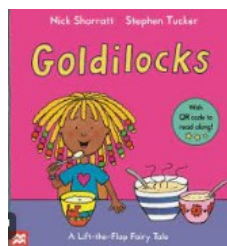
## Communication and Language

## Physical Development

## Maths

Building 9 and 10!

Within this topic we will be exploring the numbers 9 and 10. We will be learning how to recognise different representations of these numbers and developing our automatic recall of number bonds to 10.

## Consolidation

During this part of the term we will be consolidating our knowledge that we have been developing within the topic recently taught. This provides us with the opportunity to identify the areas that we need to work on to enable us to reach the Early Learning Goal.

**The objectives we are working towards are:**

- ~ Automatically recall (without reference to rhymes, counting or other aids) number bonds up to 5 (including subtraction facts) and some number bonds to 10, including double facts.

## Understanding of the World

During the second half of the Spring term we shall be exploring natural materials and using these to make constructions of different kinds. We shall be learning about plants and planting our own beans so that we can make our own observations regarding the stages it goes through. Finally we shall be learning about Easter.

**The objectives we are working towards are:**

- Looks closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change in nature.
- Makes observations of animals and plants and explains why some things occur, and talks about changes.
- Knows about similarities and differences between themselves and others, and among families, communities, cultures and traditions
