Starting Secondary School September 2022

For children born between 1 September 2010 and 31 August 2011 starting secondary school in September 2022.

The application process to apply for your child's starting secondary school place for September 2022 is now open, and will close on Sunday 31 October 2021.

Schools Open Evenings Autumn 2022

Making a late application

The closing date for on time applications was 31 October 2021.

However, you can still submit a late application online up until **20 August 2022**.

Proof of address

You are required to submit proof of address alongside your application. Please be aware that when you apply online you will not be able to attach any documentary evidence until after you have submitted your application.

Supplementary information forms

Please note some schools, such as faith schools, require the completion of a supplementary information form (SIF). This is so that they can decide which pupils should have the highest priority when making offers. SIFs are available directly from each school and their website. They must be returned to the school or to the address provided by the school by the specified deadline, which may differ between schools.

The following schools require SIFs to be completed in order to process applications. SIFs can only be considered if they have a direct bearing on oversubscription criteria or for the purpose of selection by aptitude or ability.

Schools must still accept applications without a completed SIF as all schools have to consider 'other applicants'.
